**CONDITIONAL RELEASE ORDER**

A Juvenile Court Complaint having been filed against the above-named child, and the Court having conducted a hearing thereon, the Court finds that said child should be released to his/her parent(s), Joy L. Rankin-Johnson & Michina Johnson, who reside(s) at 687 Hennepin Terrace, McDonough under the terms and conditions hereinafter stated until further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the word "parent(s)" as herein used shall mean and include the child's natural parent(s), step-parent(s), adoptive parent(s), legal custodians, foster care parent(s), guardians, or any other person with whom the child has been placed and who exercises parental guidance, supervision and control over said child.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, until final disposition of the above-referenced matter or until further Order of the Court, said child:

- 1. Shall not violate any federal, state, county, or municipal law or ordinance.
- 2. Shall report to the Juvenile Probation Officer assigned to this case at least 1 times per week/month.
- 3. Shall cooperate with the Juvenile Probation Officer assigned to said case.
- 4. Shall submit to such interviews, testing, and examinations as may be required to properly evaluate said child.
- 5. Shall attend the public school system of the county of the child's residence each and every day. Said child shall be on time for school and for each class. The child shall obey all school rules and regulations. The child shall obey the instructions given to the child by the teacher, principal, and other school officials. The child shall bring home all school books and study materials each day. The child shall be required to study a minimum of 2 hours per day under the direct supervision of the child's parent(s).
- 6. Shall ride the public transportation to and from school.

- 7. Said child's privilege and license to drive and operate a motor vehicle is hereby suspended unless authorized by the child's Juvenile Probation Officer.
- 8. Shall not associate with or have any written, verbal or physical contact with the following named individual(s):
